

# Fireworks in Nicoma Park

Size of Stand (tent size)	License Fee	Sales Tax Deposit	Clean-up Deposit

## License Fee (can be check or cash)

In order for any person, partnership, corporation or association to sell, offer for sale, or give away fireworks in Nicoma Park, they must first obtain a license from the City Clerk's Office. The licensing fee will vary depending on the size of the fireworks stand (*fee is figured on the entire tent size, not the counter size*).

## Sales Tax Deposit (cash only)

A cash Sales Tax Deposit is required at the time of licensing. This deposit will be refunded in full to the applicant if proof of sales tax payment is given to the City Clerk by September 15<sup>th</sup>. If proof of sales tax payment is not submitted to the City Clerk by September 15<sup>th</sup>, the Sales Tax Deposit will be forfeited and no Sales Tax Deposit will be refunded. It is the responsibility of the applicant to pick up the deposit from the City Clerk's Office.

## Clean-up Deposit (cash only)

A cash Clean-up Deposit is required at the time of licensing. This deposit will be refunded in full to the applicant if the temporary structure (fireworks stand) and the area around the structure is satisfactorily cleaned up within seven days after the Fourth of July. It is the responsibility of the applicant to pick up the deposit from the City Clerk's Office.

## Fireworks Sales – Dates & Hours

Fireworks can only be sold between June 26<sup>th</sup> and July 5<sup>th</sup> each year. They can be sold between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. June 26<sup>th</sup> through July 3<sup>rd</sup> and on July 5<sup>th</sup>, and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. on July 4<sup>th</sup>.

## Discharging Fireworks

Fireworks can be discharged between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. from June 26-July 5, inclusive, and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and midnight on July 4<sup>th</sup>.

Discharge of fireworks is permitted only on private property or private residences or business with the consent of the owner, occupant or tenant unless a special event permit has been issued.

Fireworks cannot be discharged within thirty (30) feet of the boundaries of NE 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and they cannot be discharged at any city park.

No discharge is permitted on any other date, time or place unless a special event permit is granted by the City Council.
